First portfolio

- 1) To oversee and support a small number of private law development projects (SP)
- 2) To oversee and support a small number of public law demonstration projects (CD)
- 3) To develop a child outcomes framework for us, working with local managers in Kent initially on the public law side. (AD)
- 4) Reviewing policy and practice in surrogacy/Parental Order cases and putting an updated practice framework in place (AD)
- 5) To review our engagement with the pan-London LSCB and individual LSCB's in London, and to come up with a fresh strategy to maximise our impact and contribution within the resources we have. (AP/SP)

Second portfolio

- 1) Litigants in person issues ((SP)
- 2) Cafcass University (SP)
- 3) Accrediting/validating outstanding services and starting a rolling programme of national service reviews (AD)
- 4) Scheme for Advanced Social Workers, including a review of use of EP's as a first step (CB)
- 5) Market testing the capacity for a new ISW market of good to outstanding practitioners (MS/AP)
- 6) London accommodation re-provision project (ER)

Third portfolio

- 1) Supporting PLO implementation, particularly the social work policy side (AD/CD)
- 2) Taking forward future policy options deemed viable
- 3) Moving to a common threshold in private law cases with local authorities, as a benchmark analysis anticipating the PLP review/work from the autumn of 2013 onwards (SP)
- 4) Reviewing adoption policy and practice in Cafcass and putting a revised practice framework in place
