## **Re: Freedom of Information Request**

Thank you for your email of 11 June 2015. You made the following requests for information:

Could you let me know if CAFCASS Officers who work on Child Protection cases are Civil Servants and therefore governed by the Civil Service Code of Conduct?

Please see below for our response.

Cafcass is an executive non-departmental public body, and Cafcass staff are therefore Public Servants, rather than Civil Servants.

In relation to a code of conduct, all of our Family Court Advisors have a contractual requirement to comply with the <u>Health Care Professional Council (HCPC) Standards of Conduct, Performance and Ethics</u>. Expectations of staff conduct are also detailed through the Cafcass <u>Employee Relations policy</u>.

We hope that you feel your question has been answered effectively. If you are unhappy with the decisions made in relation to your request, you may ask for an internal review to be undertaken. If you are dissatisfied with the way the internal review is handled or with the final decision made at that review about the information released, you are free to contact the Information Commissioner's office (www.informationcommissioner.gov.uk):
