- 1. Cafcass Cymru We recently met with Nigel Brown, CEO at Cafcass Cymru, to discuss our attendance at Advisory Committee Meetings, and other exciting future projects to work on together. We also joined a Development Day for Cafcass Cymru staff to give a presentation on who we are and some of our recent work.
- 2. Children and Young People Now Awards We are very excited to be shortlisted once again for the Family Justice Award at Children and Young People Now Awards 2021! This will be our second year being considered for the award, following our submission last year when we were congratulated as a highly commended finalist.
- 3. Social Work England Following a workshop in June on Continuing Professional Development, we have been in regular contact with Social Work England to discuss how we can work together to include the perspective of children and young people in their work. We look forward to hearing back soon on future opportunities for collaboration.
- **4. Family Justice Board Review** We met with representatives from the DfE recently to discuss what we think the priorities should be for Family Justice Board and how they can better involve

the FJYPB and the voice of the child in their meetings. We have presented our ideas at a recent FJRIG meeting and have regular contact with the DfE for updates on changes.
