TOP TIPS

For working with Trans Children and Young People

The FJYPB and Allsorts Youth Project have worked together to create these TOP TIPS to guide professionals who work with transgender children and young people.



- Never ask, suggest or dismiss a young person's trans identity as a phase. This is invalidating of their identity and could inhibit trust between you.
 - Consider creating a gender neutral toilet in your building. Trans young people have the right to access a toilet that reflects their gender identity and being prevented from doing so or fear associated with reasons from others when using the approriate bathroom can cause trans young people significant distress.
